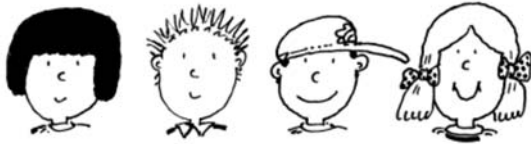

Their nick-names are Spider, Curly, Ace and Fudgy, but not in that order.

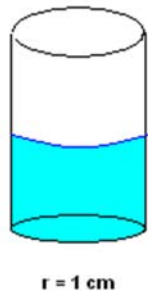
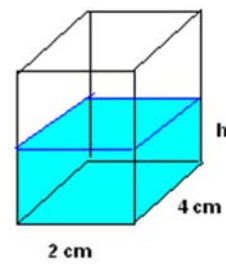
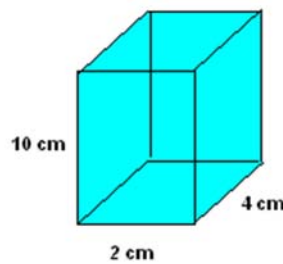
What is the nick-name of each of the friends?
